Fashion and textiles are the second largest consumer of water and produce **10%** of all carbon emissions, more than all international flights and maritime shipping combined.

The majority of textiles are sent to landfill or incinerated after use, with **LESS THAN 1%** being recycled into new clothing

- U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY(EPA)

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has found that textile waste increased from **1.76 MILLION** tonnes in 1960 to **16 MILLION** tonnes in 2015, a rise of **811%**.

The amount of textiles in landfill has also seen a sharp increase, from **1.71 MILLION** tonnes in 1960 to **10.5 MILLION** tonnes in 2015 - which equates to around **66%** of textile waste.

According to McKinsey article in 2016, the global fashion industry produces around 92 million tons of textile waste each year.

According to an EPA article from 2017, in the U.S. alone, 15 million tons of textile waste is generated annually

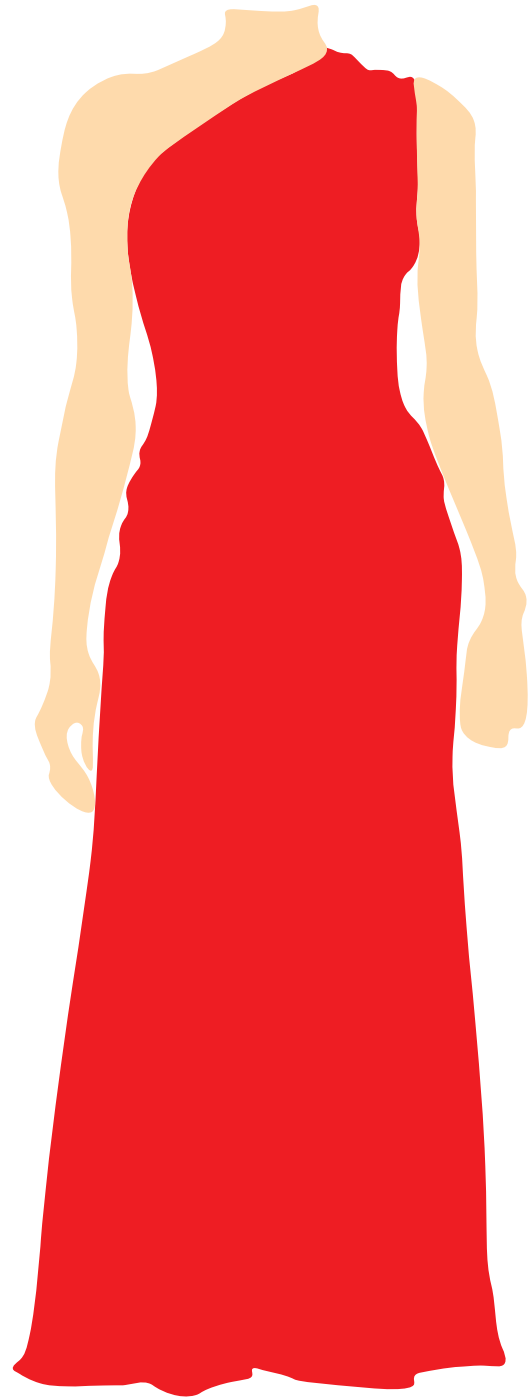
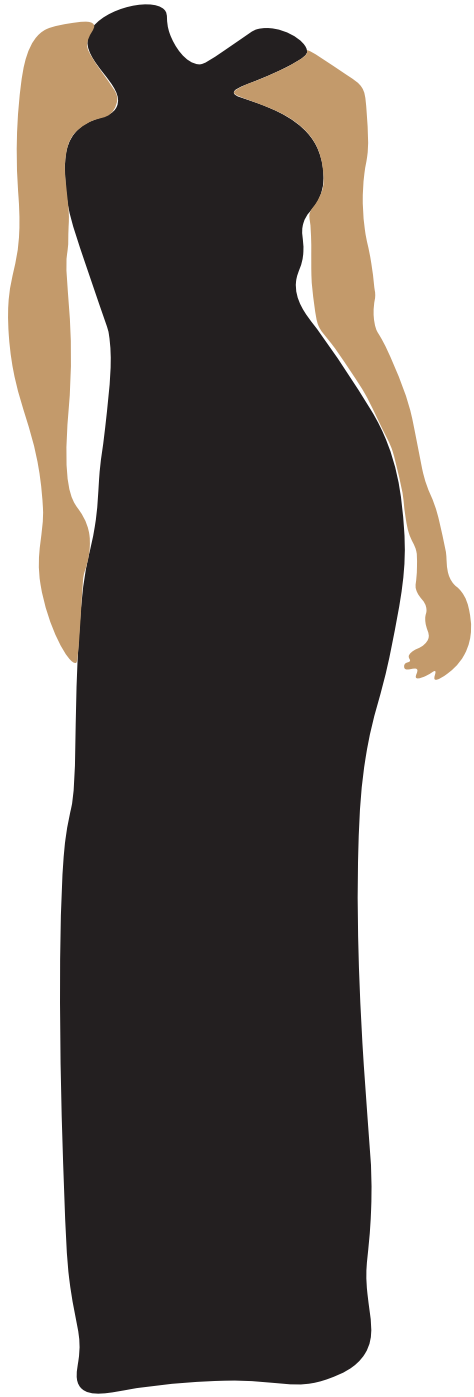
