Since March 2015, ThreadED has been collecting donations from friends and family, building a substantial inventory.






TUITION AND FINANCIAL AID

State Funding Cuts: Many educational institutions rely on state funding to subsidize tuition costs for students. However, in recent years, there have been significant cuts to state funding for higher education, resulting in a higher burden on students to cover the costs themselves.
